Guideline for General Assembly Speech

Objectives

- To provide opportunities for students to practice their public speaking skills
- To build students' confidence
- To improve students' communication skills

Procedure

- The school will open the opportunity for interested students to register via an online form on the school website. This will be done at the beginning of the academic year. Students will get the opportunity as per the list order.
- Based on the order of names noted, an assembly speech schedule will be drawn up and displayed on the parent portal. The schedule will include the names, topics and dates for the speech.
- During Ramadan time the students will not deliver their speeches.
- The topic will be given by the school. It is the parents' duty to prepare the speech and send it to the School Assembly Coordinator Ms. Zeena Mohamed (zeena.mohamed@gis.edu.mv).
- The speech should be written for 2-3 minutes. If the speech is longer than the scheduled time the school might stop the speech as the timetabled classes will begin at 07:35. School will check the speech and edit it by checking for errors and the suitability of content.
- If any child misses the assembly speech on a fixed date the student will deliver the speech next month. However, the topic will be the same.
- Parents may take photographs or video recording of their child while they are presenting. However, it should be done from a side on the corridor. Camera set up in front of the student is not allowed.

***NOTE**

- Every Monday and Wednesday Dhivehi speech will be given.
- Every Sunday, Tuesday and Thursday English speech will be given.
- The speech should be prepared 5 days before the student has to give the speech, since the speech must be checked by the school and student needs time to practice the speech.
- Parent must ensure that the student has practiced the speech well and in case the student is unable to attend, it must be informed to the Assembly Coordinator.
